PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY

For safety and security, we cannot accept someone checking you in on your behalf. This includes Teams. Each Team Member is required to check in individually at the Games Registration.

Competition(s)

Individual / Doubles

Gender

Female / Male / Combined

Team composition

Doubles will consist of 2 persons (No reserves) with Male, Female and Mixed Competitions available.

Competition structure

Singles & Doubles will be straight start. Section Play: 501 best of 3 to qualify for main round. Non-qualifiers go into Consolation Round.

Main Round: 501 best of 5 double life. Finals: 501 best of 7.

Consolation Round: Straight Knockout

SCHEDULE OF PLAY / DRAW

We can confirm the Singles competition will be played on Wednesday 8th March 2023 and the Double's competition will be played on Thursday 9th March 2023.

The Schedule of Play / Draw for your competition will be available as soon as practicable after Registration for the Games closes on 10th February 2023.







Where there are individuals who have registered for the Doubles Competitions but have not identified partners, pairs will be drawn randomly prior to the event.

The Draw will be available via the Games APP and Website.
